SITUATION:

The YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka currently serves over 80,000 people in Simcoe and Muskoka Counties in Central Ontario. With a staff complement of 700 full and part-time staff, combined with over 1,000 volunteers and donors, and an operating budget of \$18 million, the YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka serves over 16,000 annual members and participants through its seven membership centres in Barrie, Collingwood, Innisfil, Midland, Orillia, Parry Sound and Wasaga Beach; 4,000 Child Care families across a number of communities; registers 54,000 day campers in addition to 800 residence campers at YMCA Camp Kitchikewana on Beausoleil Island; over 15,000 people through leadership development, outdoor education and family programs at YMCA Geneva Park; and counsels over 20,000 people in several employment centres, including Huntsville and Parry Sound.
