Art Spark \$	Children will explore their imaginative and creative skills through a variety of arts and crafts, dramatic play, movement and musical activities. Children will have opportunities to create projects and share with others. New themes and activities are introduced each week. Materials will be provided. Fee: Member \$30.00 Non-Member \$130.00
Basketball Fundamentals \$	YMCA Basketball Fundamentals is a skill-based basketball program for children. This program blends fun games with skill exercises and a spotlight on sport specific fitness. We will guide participants to build their athletic competence, using classes that will teach the major skills and the physical literacy needed for players to succeed in the sport. Fee: Member \$30.00 Non-Member \$130.00
Teen Night Programs \$	Teen Night runs every Friday for youth ages 12 to 17. It's a drop-in program, no need to sign up ahead of time. There'll be activities offered throughout the night, for teens to participate in. Some programs may have a small cost of 2-5\$, while others will be free. Membership or Day Pass required
Chess Club *Trial*	A fun and welcoming program for youth ages 10 and up to learn and play chess. Participants will build strategy, critical thinking, and sportsmanship through mini-lessons, puzzles, and supervised games. All skill levels welcome! Membership or Day Pass Required
Outdoor Explorers \$	Learn about the environment through fun activities and wilderness games! Activities focus on nature education, physical activity and crafts. Fee: Member \$30.00 Non-Member: \$130.00
Social Butterflies \$	This program focuses on building friendships, teamwork and collaboration. Children come and do a different activity each week. Some activities may include arts and crafts, STEM creations, games, etc. Fee: Member \$30.00 Non-Member \$130.00
Youth Leaders Program is free with a classic YMCA membership	Our leadership program combines skill-building, teamwork, and volunteer opportunities to help participants develop confidence and meaningful connections with peers and the community. Youth will engage in both the aquatic and dry land streams of the YMCA leadership program, volunteer within the YMCA, enjoy fun interactive activities, and participate in the Youth Wellness program.
Youth Workplace Prep \$	Youth learn to create effective resumes and cover letters as well as what components are needed in each. Youth then plan and discuss the proper attire, behavior and skills that will excel in interviews and future co op participation.
PA Day and March Break Camps \$	The YMCA offers full-day programming on PA and school break days. The PA Day programming is designed to help your busy family manage school PA Days. Children will explore the great outdoors through scavenger hunts, animal tracking, and explorer themed group games, and get to make new friends! Camp will take place outside so please dress appropriately for all weather conditions. (Indoor) Swimming is often on our list of daily activities, so come ready to take a dip in the pool! Campers will need to pack a swimsuit and towel. Please also provide a lunch and snacks (please no products that may contain nuts), and refillable water bottle.
